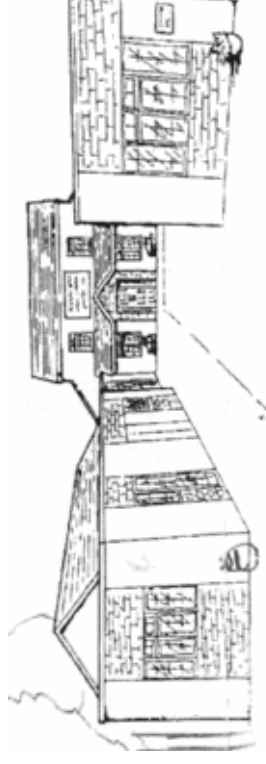

Funeral Arrangements

Whether the death occurs at home or in hospital, arrangements have to be made for the funeral. This can be done at our office, or in the comfort of your own home. Whatever you decide, please telephone first so that we may offer immediate advice. There is always a member of the Abbott family available to help and guide you during the day or night.

Following the completion of the funeral arrangements we will send out our invoice for the expenses incurred. Payment of the bill is due within 30 days of it's issue. We can accept payment by any of the following: cash, cheque, debit card, credit card.

If you are having difficulty with this, because of probate delays or other, then it is important that you contact Michael Abbott.

Help is sometimes available from the D.W.P. (formerly D.S.S.) social fund. To obtain a funeral payment pack (SF200) please telephone 221200.

An application for assistance can be made if the next of kin of the deceased is in receipt of income support, Housing Benefit, Council Tax Benefit, etc. However, please note that the D.W.P. will not cover the full cost of the funeral arrangements.

Cremated Remains

When arranging the funeral advise will be given concerning your options for resting the cremated remains. No immediate decision has to be made as we can keep them safely at our Funeral Home, for a period of time. The remains could be scattered at Kettering Crematorium, scattered at Rushden Cemetery (rose garden), buried in a local cemetery or churchyard, scattered by a member of the family or alternatively families may wish to take the remains into their own private care.

It is important to discuss possible memorials before resting the cremated remains as there are many rules and regulations to be considered first. Please ask if at all unsure.
